REVEGETATION PLANTS

- This list contains plants commonly used for revegetation projects.
- If you need other plants – see our catalogue.
- To purchase plants for revegetation projects you need to order well ahead of planting time.

Pre Order / Contract Growing:

You order your plants in advance so we can grow them for you.

To grow plants for an autumn or spring planting we need a 6 to 18(+) month lead time, depending on species.

Closing dates for pre orders:

- Fast seed grown plants - 30th of September.
- Cutting grown and autumn germinators – 28th February.

That is, Feb. & Sept. the year before planting year.

For some slower growing plants, we need an even longer lead time.

Contract Growing your plants means:

- specific provenance selection – we will grow plants from stock best suited to your area
- your plants will be ready when you are ready for planting
- discounts apply – please ask for a quotation
- a 25% deposit applies to pre orders

Sizes: most of our plants are grown in Slimline Tubes (50x50x120mm), select species can be grown in tray-systems – please enquire.

Prices: depending on species and quantities – please enquire.
