REVEGETATION PLANTS 2026

This list contains a selection of plants commonly used for revegetation projects.

We no longer grow plants on speculation, orders will need to be placed in advance.

If what you are looking for is not on the list – please ask. Excess stock may be available at certain times of the year, if you would like to be added to our mailing list let us know via email.

- To grow plants for an autumn or spring planting we need a 6 to 18(+) month lead time, depending on species. For some slower growing plants, we need an even longer lead time.

-We start taking orders in March for the following year i.e., March 2025 for planting in autumn/spring 2026. When our growing area is full orders are closed for the year.

Ordering early will ensure you don't miss out.

- Sizes: most of our plants are grown in Slimline Tubes (50x50x120mm), select species can be grown in tray-systems.

- Prices: depending on species and quantities – enquire for a quote.

A 25% non-refundable deposit applies to orders, invoiced after successful propagation.

Growing your plants to order means:

- specific provenance selection – we will grow plants from stock best suited to your area.
- the opportunity to use your own seed or to source seed from your area.
- there is time to prepare the planting site properly.
- the right plants and quantities are ready at planting time.
